- B BUDGET 2021/22. The clerk circulated a draft budget, which the council discussed. The council **RESOLVED** (proposed JD, 2nd PS) a budget of £7,500, a 0.3% rise over last year.
- C PRECEPT 2021/22. With projected income of £1,228, the council **RESOLVED** (proposed DC, 2nd JL) to demand a precept of £6,272 which is £4 less than last year. However, during the coronavirus crisis, the taxbase has fallen. Consequently, there will be a £0.03 monthly rise for Band D properties.
